

**ENVIRONMENTAL, HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY
OF
TRILOGY ENERGY CORP.**

The Board of Directors (the “Board”) of Trilogy Energy Corp. (the “Corporation”) has the responsibility for the overall stewardship of the conduct of the business of the Corporation and its subsidiaries and the activities of management of the Corporation, which is responsible for the day-to-day conduct of the business of the Corporation. Where the context requires, references to the "Corporation" refer collectively to the Corporation and all direct and indirect subsidiaries of the Corporation.

The Corporation is committed to protecting the environment, to maintaining public health and safe workplaces, and to compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and standards. The Corporation will do all that it reasonably can to ensure that sound environmental, health and safety practices are followed in all of its operations and activities.

In support of this policy, we will be guided by the following principles:

- We will comply with all applicable environmental, health and safety laws, regulations and standards.
- We will plan our projects and activities to anticipate environmental, health and safety problems and to integrate protective measures for the prevention or reduction of adverse impacts upon the environment, public health and safety in the workplaces.
- We will monitor all of our business facilities and activities to ensure that effective environmental, health and safety protection measures are maintained.
- We will ensure that our employees understand and accept responsibility for monitoring and protecting the environment, public health and safety in the workplaces.
- We will take appropriate action to repair environmental damage attributable to the Corporation’s activities.
- We will respond promptly to emergencies to minimize their consequences and protect the public, our workers and the environment.
- We will make reasonable efforts to ensure that contractors who provide services to the Corporation will operate in a manner consistent with this policy.
